California State University, Fresno is not authorized to have its own school bond like the ones K-12 school and community college districts use to repair outdated facilities and build new modern classrooms. Measure E supports California State University, Fresno by adding one penny to a \$5 purchase.

California State University, Fresno has educated over 235,000 people like us since they first opened over 100 years ago. Measure E will take Fresno State from good to great. Here are some of the things we can do:

- Expand access to career and educational programs in nursing, criminology, agriculture and engineering
- Repair campus buildings that were constructed decades ago
- Build new classrooms and laboratories
- Provide safe drinking water and safely remove asbestos, lead paint and mold
- Replace outdated fire, life safety and security systems
- Upgrade career and educational programs for veterans
- Provide scholarships for local low-income Fresno County students

Two-thirds of the money raised by Measure E must be spent on academic programs. No more than one-third can be used equally for womens' and mens' athletic facilities.

Measure E requires tough fiscal accountability to protect our local tax dollars. A five-member Citizen's Oversight Committee must publish an annual audit and hold open public meetings to determine how these funds will be spent.

What Measure Z did to make our zoo world-class, Measure E will do for Fresno State. An Economic Analysis shows that it will create nearly 20,000 jobs and generate up to \$3.7 billion in positive economic benefits.
